

IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT CONSTRUCTION IN YOUR AREA

Dear Neighbor,

As part of our long-term plan to upgrade and modernize our grid, Southern California Edison (SCE) will be making electrical upgrades in the City of Palm Springs. You will see our crews in your area making upgrades to increase reliability and customer service for you. Here are some helpful details about the work in your area to help increase safety and keep the lights on.

System upgrades you'll see in your area:

- Installation of 14 new underground vaults,
- Removal of 8 miles of old cable and installation of approximately 14 miles of new cable

Current work area:

- We're upgrading poles and equipment along streets with the following boundaries (*see map below*):

The work will occur along Indian Canyon Dr. between Ramon Road and Vista Chino in the City of Palm Springs

Anticipated Schedule

- Work in your area is underway and may be ongoing through 2015
(*note that activity will not occur at one location throughout this entire period; crews will move from location to location as work is completed*)
- Approximate timeframe: August 1 to November 1, 2014*
**This schedule may change due to weather and other factors*

What to Expect:

- For crews to work safely, it may be necessary to de-energize our power lines for short periods of time. In these cases, SCE will send notices to affected customers 72 hours prior to maintenance outages.
- SCE will use a combination of traffic control signs and crew members with flags to ensure vehicle and pedestrian safety. More updates on traffic control will come.

We understand that this work in the community can be an inconvenience to customers. We are committed to minimizing any inconvenience and ensuring the safety of the public and project personnel as we work to modernize the electric system.

We appreciate your patience as we complete this important work.
